Minimum Penalties for Academic Integrity Violation

The minimum penalties for violations of Carleton's Academic Integrity Policy are as follows:

First offence, first-year students (< 4.0 credits completed): No credit for the assessment(s) in question, or a final grade reduction of one full letter grade (e.g., A- becomes B-, if reduction results in an F, so be it), whichever is a greater reduction.

First offence (everyone else): A grade of F in the course.

Second offence: A grade of F in the course and a one-term suspension from studies.

Third offence: Expulsion from the University.

Failure to inform yourself of the expectations regarding academic integrity is not a valid excuse for violations of the policy. When in doubt, ask your instructor.
