In reply to your letter, the registrar's office of the City Hall in Miedzyrzec informs that the civil acts for years 1865-1900 are in the Archives in Lublin (13 Jezuicka Street). If the person died in Warsaw, the death certificate (???) must be in the registrar's office in Warsaw.

In this registrar's office, we have certificates of births, marriages and deaths of the Jewish people for years 1901-1938. There are no other documents. In the books for 1900-1920 Teddy Fiszleber was not found.

At the same time, we inform that there is a possibility to purchase a book titled "The History of Miedzyrzec" by Jozef Geresz. The address is: Zaklad Poligraficzno-Papierniczy "INTROGRAF", Miedzyrzec Podlaski.
